

Ernst Mach – ASEA-UNINET Short-term Research Grant



Applications for the [Ernst Mach – ASEA-UNINET Short-term Research Grant](#) are open to **postdocs** from **Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam** who would like to conduct a short research stay in Austria.

Please mind the difference between the [Ernst Mach Grant - ASEA-UNINET](#) (for a full or partial PhD study in Austria, for postdoc research stays of 3 to 9 months and for studies in the field of music) and the new **Ernst Mach – ASEA-UNINET Short-term Research Grant** announced here.

Target group:

- **Postdoc researchers** who are involved in teaching and researching at an ASEA-UNINET member university* in Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam. For a list of ASEA-UNINET member universities see www.asea-uninet.org
- Only candidates who hold the **citizenship** of one of the following countries are eligible to apply: Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam

Target country and institutions

Further requirements:

- Written consent by the host professor in Austria, by the ASEA-UNINET University Coordinators of the cooperating universities, and by the respective Asian ASEA-UNINET National Coordinator
- Max. age at time of application: 45 years (child-raising periods can be taken into account)
- Very good knowledge of English and/or German
- Applicants must not have studied/conducted research/pursued academic work in Austria in the last six months before taking up the grant.

Grant details:

- Duration: 1 or 2 months
- Grant benefit: EUR 1,150 per month; scholarship holders from Cambodia, Laos and Myanmar also receive a travel subsidy of max. EUR 1,000. *No travel subsidy from the Austrian side for scholarship awardees from other countries!*

Closing date for applications:

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis; to be submitted 2 to 9 months prior to the planned stay.
