The student may choose from one of the programs among 18 departments (Annexure "A" for the list of departments). Additional students from Thailand can enroll at the standard tuition rate, which scholarships of up to 40% available based on academic merit, as detailed in Annexure "B". The upcoming academic session is tentatively scheduled to commence in the last week of March 2025.

Tuition Fees Per Semester in USD

For Undergraduate and Masters Program for non-SAARC countries

- Citizen of non-SAARC countries – US\$ 1125 (per semester including all fees); scholarship is available upto 40% based on their academic record on that tuition fee.
- Waived tuition fees for non-SAARC countries- US\$ 180 (per semester including all fees), only 01 (one) students from each country will be eligible to get this special tuition fee.

Note: Accommodation and food is not included in the above amount. Students need a maximum of US\$ 100 (per month) to manage the food and accommodation cost. Students may stay at their own accord or under the arrangement of embassy. But if needed, BUP will make suitable arrangements for accommodation for them.
