Among Taiwan's 149 universities, STUST is a highly competitive private university of science and technology with a strong emphasis on practical training. With approximately 14,000 students, we are the fourth-largest university of science and technology in Taiwan, reflecting our strong popularity among Taiwanese students.

Our College of Engineering and College of Digital Design are accredited by IEET, the Taiwanese counterpart of ABET, which is also a Provisional Signatory of the Washington Accord, USA. In May 2017, our College of Business was accredited by AACSB and successfully passed the Continuous Improvement Review in February 2022. These accreditations demonstrate that our teaching quality has been recognized by leading international organizations.

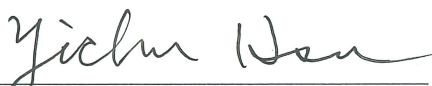

In addition to our university scholarships, we are pleased to introduce the Elite Scholarship Program, launched in Fall 2018, especially for lecturers from Southeast and South Asia. Recipients receive NT\$25,000 per month (NT\$300,000 per year), which may be used to help cover tuition, accommodation, insurance, and living expenses in Taiwan. The scholarship is awarded for up to 3 years for Ph.D. students and up to 2 years for Master's students. Please note that the number of scholarships is limited, and they are offered only to Fall semester applicants.
